1. Credit hours: 320 credit

2. Applicable Subject and Major:

Chinese language studies for exchange students

3. Course Information and Duration: For Chinese language courses, students can choose to study for one semester or one year. Each semester is about 16 weeks long.

Chinese language courses are divided into three levels: elementary, intermediate and advanced. Each level is subdivided into 2 sub-level classes. Students need to take placement test (written test and oral test) to decide which level of class they will be in. Each student is sure to find a class suitable for him or her at Beijing Institute of Technology.

Exchange students who have successfully completed the courses outlined in the academic plan and achieved passing grades will receive a "Certificate of Completion from the Beijing Institute of Technology". Those who have not completed all required courses, failed to meet attendance standards, did not take the exam, or failed the exam (including those who did not pass in the re-sit paper) will not receive a completion certificate. Instead, they will only receive a study certificate.
